Cherry Valley 30 K Time Trial: The Start location for the Cherry Valley 30 K Time Trial will NOT be at Bauman Park in Cherry Valley. The new start location will be at the Kishwaukee Elementary School in Garden Prairie, Illinois. (10 Miles East of Cherry Valley on Hwy 20). The 30 K time trial is on an out and back flat course. It is a bicycle race where each rider competes against the clock. The riders will start at one minute intervals beginning at 9:00 am from Kishwaukee Elementary School. Any type of bicycle is allowed as long as it is safe and the riders must wear an approved safe helmet.

MATTS Race Classes: Junior Open, Junior Women, Cat. 1/2, Cat. 3, Cat. 4, Women Open, Women Cat. 4, Master 30+, Master 40+, Master 50+, Master 60+, Master 65+, Master 70+, Master Women 40+, Master Women 50+, Master Women 60+ and Tandem. *Junior under 14 compete for three place awards and will receive points in Junior Open or Junior Women classes for MATTS overall prizes.

REGISTRATION: Entry Fee: Early registration \$17 (before April 23) Race day registration \$20
Juniors racing Junior category race free. For second race add \$10. **For Early Registration:** Submit a ABR 2004 Release Form with entry fee payable to **Wisconsin Bicycle Racing and mail to: Wisconsin Bicycle Racing, 1306 Washington Rd., Kenosha, WI 53140.** After April 23 the entry fee is \$20. **Day of race registration:** Will open at 8:00am at Kishwaukee Elementary School in Garden Prairie, Illinois **Starting order:** Is based on order of registration. First to register is first out. First rider will leave at 9:01am and others follow at one minute intervals.

DIRECTIONS: Garden Prairie is located 10 miles East of Cherry Valley. If you are coming from the Chicago area on I-90 exit the HWY 20 exit and go through Marengo and continue west to Garden Prairie Rd in Garden Prairie and turn right (North) on Garden Prairie Rd. about ½ mile to the Kishwaukee Elementary School. Coming from Rockford / Cherry Valley take HWY 20 (Not BR 20) to Garden Prairie, Illinois and turn left (North) on Garden Prairie Rd. about ½ mile to the Kishwaukee Elementary School.

AWARDS: MATTS: Medals awarded five deep in all classes except Tandems and Juniors which are three deep. Points awarded towards 2004 MATTS \$5000 in overall Season cash prizes.

Profile for Speed: Rider entry raffle for merchandise (Profile Aero Bars).

Fastest Overall Riders: Fastest times for the day cash awards (1st \$30, 2nd \$20, 3rd \$10). If more than 150 riders compete there will be 5 places for Fastest time cash awards. (1st \$50, 2nd \$40, 3rd \$30, 4th \$20, 5th \$10) **Tandem and recumbent bicycles not eligible for fastest times)
