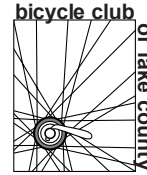


The Bicycle Club of Lake County Presents the 23rd Annual

A Recreational Bicycle Ride

The ride begins at the Kenosha County Fairgrounds in Wilmot, Wisconsin. Routes are 30, 50, 70, or 100 miles; SAG and rest stops are included. The 23rd Annual BCLC Ramble pedals its way over urban and rural roads which traverse the scenic lakes region of northeastern Illinois and southeastern Wisconsin. The terrain is flat to rolling. Just for the fun of it, we threw in some roller coaster hills and a challenging hill or two.

The BCLC Ramble is a recreational ride, not a race. Riders of all capabilities are encouraged to participate and enjoy the scenery, good food, and fellowship offered at the ride.

Safety

Your safety is important to the Bicycle Club of Lake County. Please obey all traffic laws, operate your bicycle in a safe manner (including riding single file when cars are present), and practice rider courtesy. We believe bicyclists deserve to share the

road; do not ride in such a way that would make motorists feel otherwise. The Bicycle Club of Lake County strongly recommends the use of a helmet while riding a bicycle.

Registration and Fees

The start and finish are at the Kenosha County Fairgrounds in Wilmot, Wisconsin. Ample parking and restrooms will be available. Registration is open from 6:00 a.m.-10:00 a.m. Century riders must start by 8:00 a.m. The Genoa City rest stop will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. All riders must be off the route at 5:00 p.m. when the SAG support ends.

Your registration fee gets you more than just a map. Once registered you are entitled to make use of our quality rest stop stocked with homemade cookies, sandwiches, fruit, and snacks. The routes will be monitored by support "SAG" vehicles prepared to lend a hand, in the event of a problem.

The registration fee is \$12.00 if you register on or before June 1, 2004 or \$17.00 after June 1, 2004. On-line registration is available at the BCLC website www.bikebclc.com and at www.active.com.

Directions to Wilmot, WI.

From the north: Take I-94 south to exit 344 (Hwy. 50), turn right at the end of the ramp and go west on Hwy. 50 for 8.4 miles, then turn left onto Route 83 south for 3.4 miles, then turn right onto CR C west for 4.7 miles, then turn right onto CR W north for 0.25 miles, then turn left into the fairground entrance.

From the south: Take I-94/I-294 north, exit at Route 173, turn left at the top of the ramp onto Route 173 west for 13.1 miles, then turn right at Wilmot Road north (becomes Fox River Rd. then CR W) for 2.7 miles, then turn left into the fairground entrance.

If the entrant is a minor, I, the minor's parent and/or legal guardian, understand the nature of bicycling activities and the minor's experience and capabilities and believe the minor to be qualified to participate in such activity.

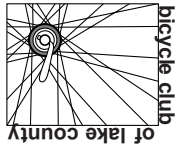

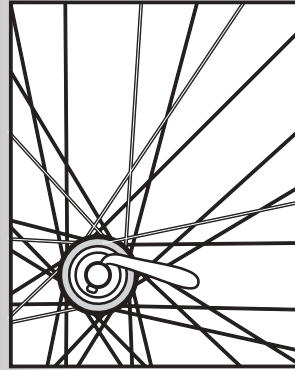

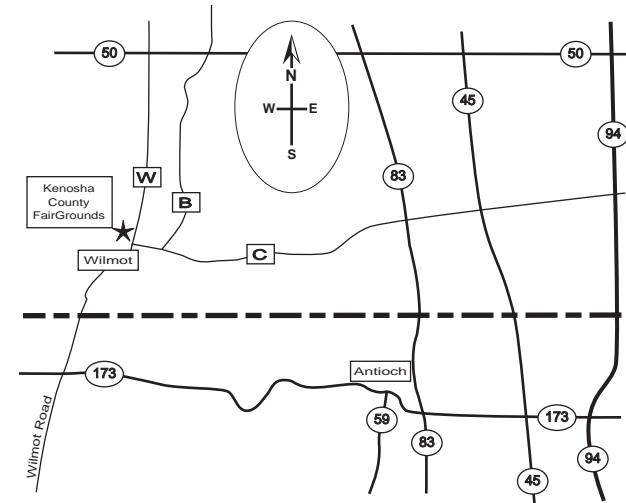
