Up for grabs will be a cool IRS jacket, over \$6000 in cash, plus bragging rights about who is the best road racer in the Midwest. In addition, a special team challenge will be included in the CAT 2/3 and MAS 40+ categories.

The races that will make up the Series are:

- 1. **McCormick's Creek Road Race**. A fun little 4.5 mile loop that throws a little at you each lap. Received favorable reviews last year look for more the same in 2007! Date: April 7
- 2. **Pikes Peak Road Race**. An unparalleled course, literally, as you go up and down and take in the great scenery of Brown County with each undulation. This will be the measure of your early season fitness level. The cemetery climb will long be remembered for its burial of toasted legs after the day is done. This 12.4 mile loop throws the book at you with moderate to severe climbs, twisting high speed descents, rolling landscapes in the distance, smooth roads, light traffic, and false flats for dropping the hammer. Date: April 22
- 3. **Morgan-Monroe State Forest Road Race**. A course that just got a facelift for 2007. New pavement all over the place Forest Road, Bean Blossom climb, Old SR 37. What more can you ask for? A 14 mile loop that is the envy of all other road races. Put this one on the schedule and circle it. Come and make some noise on top of Mt. Bean! Date: May 6
- 4. **Eagle Creek Park Traditional Crit**. A .95 mile scenic loop that rides more like a road race course than a crit. The slight uphill finish will test the riders form and is a great place to attack. A beautiful park and the 2nd oldest IRS next to Mooresville is a welcome addition to the spring series. Special thanks to Black Mountain Musicals and Indy Hand Center for helping with this race. Date: May 12
- 5. **Saint Crispian Road Race**. A race so good that only Shakespeare can match it. The granddaddy of them all, the Crispy is the penultimate race of the Series. Mark your calendar and get ready for an epic 55 mile loop that ends on top of the first climb. We wouldn't have it any other way. Date: June 3

The details of the IRS '07 Spring Road Race Series are as follows:

The cost is \$27.00 per race, except for Saint Crispian (\$30.00), where some of the proceeds go to Bret Neylon, the Lion King. Non-ABR members, please add \$3.00. Citizens and Juniors pay only \$25.00

Points will be awarded to the top 30 in each race. Individual totals of the 5 events will be added and the racers with the highest totals win (tie breaker will be the highest placing of the last race of the series). You must do at least 4 races to be eligible for the overall. In addition, Eagle Creek Park prime points will be up for grabs.

For the Team Challenge in the CAT 2/3 and MAS 40+ categories, the winning team will walk away with some great prizes. Your particular team must do a 40KM Team TT to be eligible for the above awards. For the team TT, the top team will earn 100 points, 2nd place - 90 points, 3rd place - 85 points, 4th place - 80 points, 5th place - 75 points, 6th place - 70 points, etc. A roster of your team members must be submitted prior to the first race of the year and will be posted to the IRS web site. The team TT needs to be done by July 1st and will be scored like in year's past with the top 3 team members earning points toward the Team Challenge up to the top 30 placings. Standings will be tracked and reported on the IRS website.

In the event that a Spring Road Race has to be cancelled due to cold, snow, heavy rain, etc. we will do our best to reschedule that race later in the season. Should we be unable to reschedule, another race will be added to complete the series.
